LINEARITY

Modular kitchens tend to become linear kitchens wherever there is scope. They are long; and not very tall. This lends the kitchen space with a much bigger appearance. Linearity is the most compact layout we can get, with all the vital elements in a kitchen-such as sink, appliances, cooktop, food preparation area, storage, etc.) placed one next to the other on a single wall.

MIXING TEXTURES

Most of the modular kitchens exhibit a tendency to mix textures. Mixing the texture of timber with that of stone will constitute an example for this. Another example would be giving a stone finish or wood finish to a stainless steel surface. Such ingenious mixing can bring forth altogether new and different finishes.



MIXING MATERIALS

Mixing is also possible with materials. For example, ceramics can be mixed with sandblast. Likewise high gloss can be mixed with matt tone; metal can be mixed with porcelain or engineered stones, and marine ply's with MDF/PPB. Such imaginative mixing can pave way to amazing possibilities. And modular kitchen architects/designers have been optimally exploring these possibilities.

INTEGRATED TECHNOLOGY

Thanks to the technological strides that we have been making, integrated technology has been another salient feature of modular kitchens. Today, we have very high-end technological marvels about which we could not have even dreamt of in the past. For example, today, at the press of a button we can have cooker hood extractors coming up from a kitchen island.

There are a couple of different options. Some cabinet doors and drawers have a simple groove cut into the edge of the design. When the user inserts her finger/s into these grooves they provide the services of handles for all practical purposes.

MONOCHROMATIC COLOURS

Monochromatic colours are all the tints, tones, and shades of a single colour. Monochromatic colour schemes are derived from a single base colour and extended by using the different shades, tones and tints of that very colour. Monochromatic colours have become a craze with modular kitchen designers.
